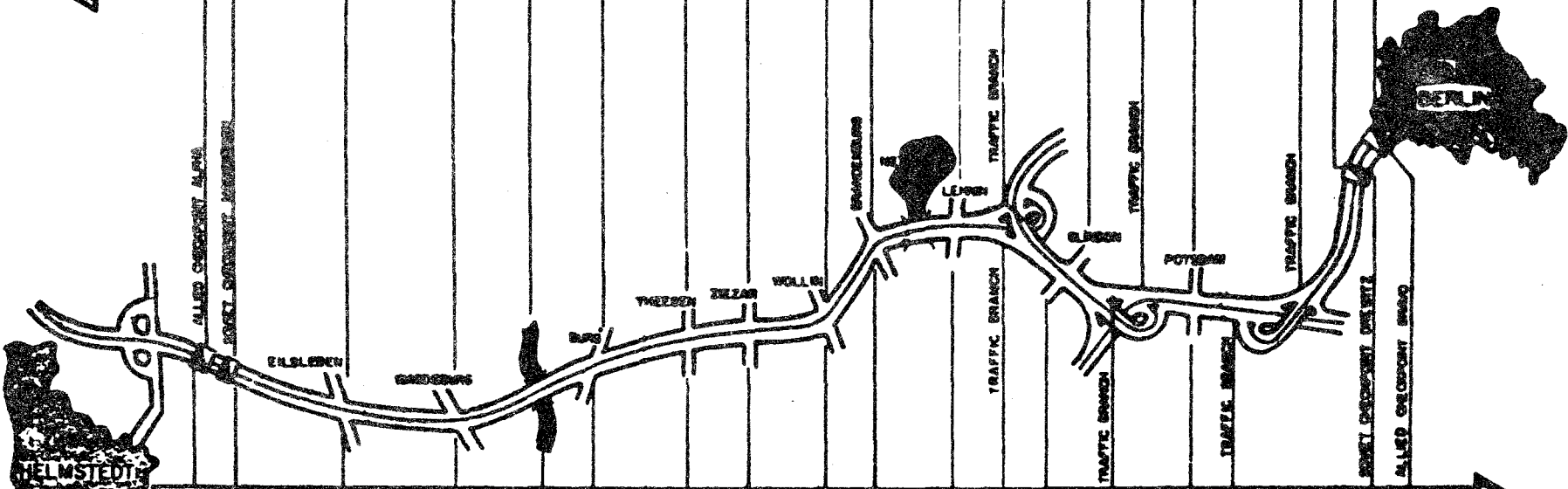

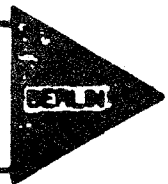

INSTRUCTIONS

1. When you breakdown slip arrives at the US Checkpoint, your position will be calculated from your speedometer reading, and your location as indicated on the reverse side. It takes time for the wrecker or other help to get to you, so be prepared to wait.
2. The autobahn is measured by kilometer marker stones at every  $\frac{1}{2}$  km. The km stone at the BERLINER RING (3rd turn-off FROM BERLIN) reads 0 km. The km stone at Checkpoint "ALPHA" reads 130 km.
3. Indicate your location by placing an "X" in between known reference points on the front side of this breakdown slip.
  - a. If possible, move your vehicle to the edge of the Autobahn.
  - b. Send your slip by an Allied, West German, or West Berlin traveler that you know is going to Helmstedt or West Berlin. The other slip goes in the opposite direction, by the same type of traveler.
  - c. Having sent the slip, don't move until help arrives.

NOTE: East German license plates have ONE distinct GROUP of LETTERS followed by TWO separate GROUPS of NUMBERS: IA 92-47. West German license plates have TWO separate GROUPS of LETTERS followed by ONE distinct GROUP of NUMBERS: B-TR 165.
