Mr. GUYER of Kansas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Military Affairs

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of War to retain Brigadier General Benjamin O. Davis, United States Army, on active duty with combat troops.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized
4 to retain Brigadier General Benjamin O. Davis, United
5 States Army, on active duty with combat troops, in the
6 rank and grade in which he is now serving, until he attains
7 the age of sixty-five years, without reference to section 945,
8 chapter 26, title 10, United States Code: *Provided*, That he
9 may be retired whenever he is found incapacitated for active
10 service by reason of physical disability.
