2ND INTERVIEW QUESTIONS**

The following questions can be asked during the second interview, if they were not addressed in the first interview, or to clarify or gather more information.

- What did you think about the quality of the leadership and training during your service?
- Do you remember any examples of good leadership?
- Do you remember any examples of bad leadership?
- What was the most serious thing you did or saw during your service?
- Do you remember any examples of bravery or dedication?
- Do you remember any funny things that happened?
- Did you have any piece of equipment you really liked?
- Did you have any piece of equipment you really disliked?
- What was the best part about your job?
- What was the worst?
- What was it like spending the holidays in the service?
- What did you do for fun?
- How did you get the news?

If the service member was deployed overseas or on a ship:

- What was it like to travel overseas? How did you get to your destination?
- Tell me about your first time aboard a ship. OR: Tell me about arriving overseas.
- What did you think about the local people you interacted with?
- What did you like about the country you served in?
- What did you dislike about serving overseas?
- How did you stay in touch with people back home?
- What were living conditions like?
- Where did you sleep?
- How was the food?
