With 3<sup>rd</sup> Cavalry stationed at Russell during the 1876 Sioux War. Includes letter to Chief of Ordnance S.V. Benet, 6 Aug 1876, disputing newspaper accounts that claimed carbines failed to eject cartridges at the Battle of Rosebud, where Henry was severely wounded.
