## **RAPID DEPLOYMENT FORCES SINCE 1977**

The Rapid Deployment Force (RDF) is a relatively recent development. Its concept of a quick-reaction force for deployment to Southwest Asia was born in a 1977 review of US defense policy. Subsequent planning led to the formation in late 1979 of the Rapid Deployment Joint Task Force (RDJTF), a component of the US Readiness Command (REDCOM). Headquarters RDJF was activated Mar 1980 at MacDill AFB, Florida. Continued modification of the RDF concept and structure created the new US Central Command (CENTCOM), a unified command that replaced RDJFT.
