Deploy -- Move forces to or within area of operations.

- **Redeploy** -- Transfer forces:
 - 1 within that area,
 - 2 to new area, or
 - 3 back to USA for further deployment.
- Demobilize Revert from military to civilian status or from war to peace condition.

Reduction -- Decrease size or composition.
