<u>PRE-1948</u>

During WWII and the pre-comptroller era, technical advice to commanders on resource management appears to have been provided piecemeal by various staff sections, notably G-1 and G-4, and sometimes a special staff section responsible for fiscal and financial affairs. The Control Division of Army Service Forces performed comptroller-like, managerial functions in the continental United States, while its European Theater counterpart was the Control Division of the Communications Zone.
