 Archives, which include personal papers of officers and enlisted men who served at the Panama Canal: Paul Adams, Lucius Clay, George Decker, Andrew Goodpaster, Matthew Ridgway, Willis Crittenberger, and Lawrence Halstead, Sr. The first four individuals briefly discuss the Canal in their oral history transcripts, while the latter three have donated more extensive collections of papers. General Ridgway's personal and official correspondence covers his Caribbean Defense Command service in the late 1940's. General Crittenberger reiminiscences about a tour in the Canal, 1945-1947, and the Lawrence Halstead Canal diary covers 1935-1938. Frank McSherry Papers include several boxes of material covering 1946-1950.
