**NOTE:** Selection for individual rotation was prescribed by CIC Far East Command. See DA Circ 28 (13 Apr 1951), Para 4 and the FEC circular reprinted in Skinrood's study cited below. Summary of policy: Spring 1951-6 month duty in combat unit. Fall 1951-credit points for each month spent in designated zones. Average tour = 10-11 mo for combat soldiers.
