NOTE: THE SOLDIER'S BOOK, 1835-45

According to General Regulations 1835, Art IX, Para 41, this "book" was furnished each soldier in order to "...record the military history of its possesser...," to wit, his pay, allowances, service and conduct. It apparently served as an individual pay and personnel record, not as an instructional manual or handbook.

Administrative aspects of the 1835 <u>Soldier's Book</u> can be traced in U.S. War Dept General Orders <u>No 10</u>, 1835; <u>No 11</u>, 1837; <u>Nos 26, 54 and 60</u>, 1839; and <u>No 30</u>, 1844. <u>General Order 15</u> of 1845 (not on file) ended its use.
