Major military events, included John C. Fremont's trip into the Klamath region in 1843-1844 and the affairs with the Klamath-Modoc tribes in the 1850's and '60's. Also noteworthy are the Williamson-Abbott railroad survey on the east side of the Cascades in 1855 and the Japanese balloon "attacks" of World War II, chiefly near Bly, at Gearhart Mountain.
