**ENDNOTE:** Troops under command of Col Albert Sidney Johnston in the fall of 1857: 5<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 8 companies of 10<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 8 companies of 2<sup>nd</sup> Dragoons, plus Phelps' light battery and Reno's heavy battery of artillery. The next spring, the following units were ordered to Utah as reinforcements: 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry, two companies of 2<sup>nd</sup> Dragoons, 6<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry, and two light batteries of 2<sup>nd</sup> Artillery.
