SOCIETY OF THE ARMY OF THE POTOMAC

Founded in 1869, there were few members were former enlisted men. The first president was General George B. McClellan. At times, its directorate interlocked with the Grand Army of the Republic. In its early years, the Society expressed hostility towards Southerners and Mormons. In the 1890s, it manifested concern about flag desecration and enthusiasm for the Cuban freedom-fighters. Most members favored a large military establishment, but occasionally anti-war orators were heard at the annual reunions. See:
