WAR DEPARTMENT SEAL & PLAQUE

The Board of War, established by Continental Congress, 13 Jun 1776, was authorized by Congress to affix a seal to military commissions issued by the War Office and signed by the president of Congress. That authorization appears in Journal of the Continental Congress, dated 8 Mar 1779, even though the seal appears on commissions dated earlier. The same design with minor changes continued in use by the War Department and after 1947 by the Department of the Army. See:
