The 11th Armored Division, nicknamed the "Tiger Division," was activated on 15 August 1942, at Camp Polk, Louisiana. After undergoing training and participating in the Louisian Maneuvers and later, the California Maneuvers, the division deployed to the European Theater of Operations (ETO), arriving in France in December 1944. The division entered Germany on 5 March 1945 and later was inactivated in Germany on 31 August 1945.

Organized as a "light" armored division, the 11th Armored Division evolved around three tank battalions containing some 245 light and medium tanks. Each tank battalion consisted of three medium tank companies and one light tank company. Light armored divisions also had three armored infantry battalions, each consisting of a headquarters and headquarters company, a service company and 3 armored rifle companies.
